Through the generosity of donors and the income earned on invested funds, JMECA assists the Province with funding of approximately £250,000 each year to support the local clergy and their work in the communities they serve.

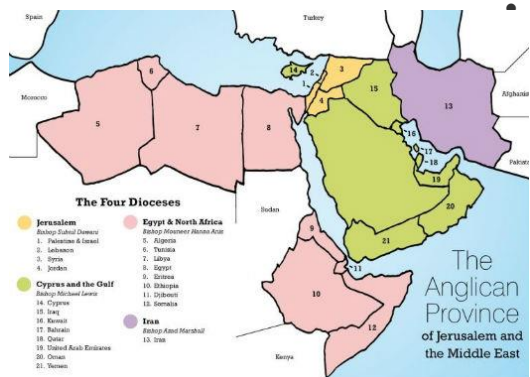
